WHAT DOES CCBANK
DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.	
What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Security number and Credit History • Income and Employment Information • Payment history and Wire Transfer Instructions <p>When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>	
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons CCBank chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Who is providing this notice?	CCBank means Capital Community Bank, Inc. doing business as CCBank.
What We Do	
How does CCBank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also maintain other physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect this information and we limit access to information to those employees for whom access is appropriate.
How does CCBank collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Apply for a loan; give us your contact information ■ Give us your income information; show your government-issued ID ■ Provide employment information We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness ■ affiliates from using your information to market to you ■ sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>CCBank does not share with our affiliates.</i>
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>Nonaffiliates we share with can include financial institutions and servicing companies.</i>
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>Our joint marketing partners include other financial service companies, insurance companies and direct marketing companies or providers of products or services that may be of interest to our customers.</i>
